3. LCCMR FY2012-2013 Administrative Budget

Susan Thornton presented the LCCMR administrative budget for \$591,000 each year of FY2012-2013 biennium. This is reduced from the current \$625,000 each year for the current biennium and originally proposed for FY2012-2013.

Susan Thornton stated that the LCCMR administrative budget was reduced 7.5 percent from what was presented in July 2010 due to changing to a biennial cycle with fewer meetings, no staff salary increases and other budgetary adjustments. Ms. Thornton reviewed the list of ongoing projects with members and noted there are approximately 396 active projects. Ms. Thornton suggested members review the list of projects and provide any recommendations to staff regarding projects for which they may be interested in receiving more information.

Commissioner Howes asked staff to compile what the budgetary impacts would be if the House removed per diem and housing allowance during the interim.

MOTION: Commissioner Frederickson moved to adopt as a recommendation the LCCMR FY2012-2013 Administrative Budget – motion prevailed.
