#### **Appropriation Language:**

\$1,645,000 the first year is to the Board of Water and Soil Resources to acquire permanent conservation easements and restore wetlands and associated upland habitat in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture Wetlands Reserve Program. A list of proposed land acquisitions must be provided as part of the required work program.

**I. PROJECT TITLE:** Reinvest in Minnesota Wetlands Reserve Acquisition and Restoration Program Partnership

#### **II. PROJECT SUMMARY:**

The Reinvest in Minnesota (RIM) - Wetlands Reserve Program (WRP) partnership is a local-state-federal partnership delivered locally by the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), the Board of Water and Soil Resources (BWSR) and county Soil and Water Conservation Districts (SWCDs). The goal of the RIM-WRP partnership is to achieve the highest quality wetland and native grassland restorations in order to maximize wetland functions and values and to optimize wildlife habitat on every acre enrolled in the program. Land enrolled in the RIM-WRP program is protected with perpetual conservation easements. ENTRF funds will be used to secure permanent conservation easements on a proposed 1500 acres of private lands through the RIM-WRP partnership, as part of a larger effort to protect and restore the drained Crooked Lake basin in Douglas County, MN.

Prior to its drainage in the early 1900s, Crooked Lake was a shallow, flat bottomed lake that likely supported diverse communities of aquatic and emergent plants, invertebrates, and migratory water fowl. The Crooked Lake Restoration project is a multi-partner project that aims to restore over 2200 acres of wetlands and almost 1200 acres of associated upland/grasslands around the drained shallow lake bed, which was the original headwaters lake for the 90 mile Sauk River. This unique project will have numerous ecological benefits including reduced nutrient loading and sedimentation to nearby (impaired) Lake Osakis and improved water quality throughout the Sauk River watershed. Thousands of acres of critical wildlife habitat will be restored, and flooding stresses on landowners within the project area will be greatly reduced. The Crooked Lake restoration project was deemed a Federal priority in 2011 by USDA under the Mississippi River Basin Initiative (MRBI) through the Wetland Reserve Enhancement Program (WREP). Douglas County SWCD was granted \$7M in WREP funding for easement acquisition in the Crooked Lake project area. The combination of WREP funding and ENTRF funding will allow for the easement acquisition necessary to move forward with this substantial restoration project.

ENTRF funds will be used for easement acquisition, SWCD acquisition services, and BWSR project management only. Restoration and monitoring will be completed using other funds.

#### IV. PROJECT ACTIVITIES AND OUTCOMES:

**ACTIVITY 1:** Acquire Reinvest in Minnesota-Wetland Reserve Program conservation easements on approximately 1500 acres within the Crooked Lake Restoration area

#### **Description:**

24 perpetual RIM/WRP easements are proposed on approximately 1500 acres within the Crooked Lake restoration area. Proposals were sent to eligible landowners via Douglas County SWCD and the application process is underway. The proposed easement acres are the minimum acres required to restore the basin to 2 feet above the proposed pool elevation. Landowners will have the option to enroll more acres, but the acres proposed will be sufficient to allow restoration of the basin to occur. Eligible applications that are selected for RIM-WRP funding are required to undergo a comprehensive site analysis which will ultimately determine the final easement acres.

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Under the RIM-WRP partnership, easements are held by NRCS for the first 30 years, and then the perpetual RIM easement takes over. Once a RIM-WRP easement is acquired, NRCS is responsible for the maintenance, inspection and monitoring of the site during the life of their 30-year WRP easement, including all associated costs for these activities. The state of Minnesota assumes sole responsibility via its perpetual RIM Reserve easement once the 30-year WRP easement has expired. The BWSR partners with local SWCDs to carry out monitoring and oversight of its conservation easements, to ensure compliance with easement restrictions and covenenants and to ensure that the site continues to meet program goals into perpetuity. RIM funds used for acquisiton of remaining parcels will provide the funds associated with long-term monitoring for the entire project.

#### **VII. PROJECT STRATEGY:**

**A. Project Partners:** Partners involved in the easement acquisiton using ENTRF funds include Douglas Soil and Water Conservation district, USDA-NRCS, and the Board of Water and Soil Resources. The federally funded Crooked Lake MRBI-WREP project has various other partners including Ducks Unlimited, the Sauk River Watershed District, Vikings sportsman club, and Lake Osakis Lake Association.

**B. Project Impact and Long-term Strategy** The \$1.645 million ENTRF appropriation will allow the state to leverage \$2.632 million in federal WRP funding towards easement acquisition. The funding will allow us to protect 1500 or more acres with permanent conservation easements, and accelerate the effort to restore and protect thousands of acres of wetlands and grasslands within the Crooked Lake Basin. Remaining easements will be obtained under the WREP program, or with additional RIM WRP funding. As previously mentioned, restoration will be compelted using other funding. Ducks unlimited will provide a portion of restoration costs associated with the survey, design, and construction of a water control structure to ultimately restore Crooked Lake. In October the BWSR Board allocated up to \$5M in 2012 bond funds for RIM to leverage the NRCS MRBI-WREP Initiative.
