
LCCMR Process for 2015 Recommendations

In response to the 2015 Request for Proposal (RFP), due March 28, 2014, 152 proposals requesting a total of approximately \$126.3 million were received. This RFP process is for funding available beginning July 1, 2015. For that period, approximately \$44 million from the Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund is expected to be available to recommend for project funding.


% of Total \$ Requests Received by Funding Priority Topic Areas


