

## LCCMR Member 2025 RFP Feedback Survey – Results

Several changes to the 2025 RFP were suggested during the LCCMR meeting on November 16, 2023. LCCMR staff put together a survey to generate feedback on the proposed changes to the RFP, and below are the results of that survey. LCCMR staff also provided a [draft of the 2025 RFP](#) that includes changes that were suggested in the meeting.

Number of Members Responding: 13 (5 Citizen Members, 4 House Members, 4 Senate Members)

- 1) Do you support **adding** "PFAS and microplastics" and **deleting** "PAHs" as shown under Water Resources (Category B, subsection 2) on page 3 of the draft RFP?

- 2) Do you support **deleting** "Proposals to develop new curriculum will not be considered" as shown under Environmental Education (Category C, subsection 2) on page 4 of the draft RFP?
