


Built 2020

Funding this Emerging Issue

Outcomes

- Overall project delivery is expedited.
- Complete feasibility study and define shoreline mitigation alternatives.
- Preparation of plan and specifications for construction.
- Construction of the project.

Benefits

- Addressing an environmental issue by permanently stabilizing 300 feet of shoreline.
- Stop the continual exposure and loss of human remains.
- Preservation of the cemetery and its historical land markers.
- Reduce sediment and nutrient loading to Lake Superior.
