#### **Work Program Summary**

#### **Overall Project Outcome and Results**

The goal of our 'Campaign for Conservation' Phase III Work Program was to acquire up to 300 acres in large blocks to help piece together fragmented landscapes and natural communities and complement other partners' initiatives by protecting a variety of high quality habitat thus maximizing the benefit to the greatest number of species. Properties acquired were to be retained by the Conservancy as additions to or links between its preserves, transferred to the Department of Natural Resources as additions to the Wildlife Management Area system, or acquired collaboratively with and held by other Habitat Corridors partners. In this work program, partners had the option to acquire either fee-title or easement acquisition. For phase III, TNC expended \$87,914 on acquiring easements and \$262, 086 was spent on fee-title acquisition.

The Conservancy received \$350,000 from the Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund for land acquisition. With these funds, the Conservancy acquired a conservation easement on 33 acres in the Mississippi Bluff Lands project area and acquired 95.08 acres in fee title in three projects in the Aspen Parklands, Central Lakes and Alexandria Moraine project areas.

In this time period, the Conservancy spent \$555,144 of its private funds and leveraged \$122,888 in additional partner funds on five land acquisition and conservation easement acquisition projects in the Mississippi Headwaters, Border Prairie, and Southern Lakes project areas, resulting in the permanent protection of an additional 523 acres.

#### **Project Results Use and Dissemination**

The Conservancy publicized its work on these projects via press releases, membership publications, presentations and the Conservancy's website. The Conservancy also participated in publicizing the overall accomplishments of the Habitat Corridors project as it reached significant mile marks.

Description: With a portion of its LCCMR Phase III funding, the Minnesota Chapter of The Nature Conservancy

purchased 40 acres in Polk County on February 4, 2008. As soon as all conditions for transferring were met, this tract was conveyed to MN DNR as a gift for inclusion in the surrounding 1,350-acre Maple Meadows Wildlife Management Area. The Ida Martinson Trust tract was the last unprotected private land in this section and was at risk of being sold to a private party and further developed. The DNR Wildlife

Program will demolish the abandoned house and restore the home site to the surrounding habitat, a mosaic

of wet prairie, sedge meadow, brush thickets, and scattered groves of aspen. Eliminating private

ownership within the boundaries of the WMA should also enable better stewardship of these fire-dependent

systems.
