Work Program Summary

Overall Project Outcome and Results

The purpose of this grant was to fund land acquisition work by Ducks Unlimited (DU) to purchase 20 acres with \$50,000 of grant funds and \$10,000 of other partner funds (e.g., DU or NAWCA), while using \$10,000 in grant funds for DU land protection staff and contributing \$4,000 of in-kind DU staff time and travel expense in the process.

Due to rising land prices and limited funding for this acquisition work, and growing opportunities to fund land protection via permanent conservation easements, funds from Trust Fund grant work program were transferred to HCP part 3c for DU conservation easements as approved by LCCMR staff in July 2006 due to lack of fee-title acquisition opportunities on shallow lakes within the limited \$50,000 project budget.

The land is located at the head of Judicial Ditch 15 and is adjacent to more than 600 acres of permanently and restored habitat.

After restoration in 2008-09, this tract will provide prairie and wetland habitat for a host of wildlife species, ensuring excellent waterfowl and wildlife habitat benefits.

Project Results Use and Dissemination

This grant helped DU refine and focus our land protection work on permanent conservation easements instead of land acquisitions. However, as a result of reallocating the funds to part 3c, no accomplishments were achieved and therefore no dissemination of results was undertaken by DU. ETF funds for this work program were transferred to 3c for conservation easements as approved by LCCMR staff in July 2006 due to lack of fee-title acquisition opportunities on shallow lakes within the \$50,000 budget.
