Dear President Metzen:

I have received, approved, signed, and deposited in the Office of the Secretary of State, Chapter 143, Senate File 1012, the LCCMR appropriations bill with the exception of the line item vetoes listed below:

- 1. <u>Page 10, lines 10.21 10.33</u>: A \$275,000 appropriation for endocrine disruptor research. There is over \$1 million in funding for endocrine disruptor research in HF 1231 which will allow the research to move forward appropriately.
- 2. <u>Pages 14 & 15</u>, <u>lines 14.29 15.2</u>: A \$143,000 appropriation to analyze options to "Decarbonize Minnesota's Electrical Power System." The language and direction relating to this appropriation is vague and appears to call for a study of a previous study and its resulting recommendations. The previous effort was sufficient, and in this time of financial crisis we should avoid funding the study of previous studies.
